### Helpful Hint #9: Tips for the New TraumaMan System



*TraumaMan Owners:* It is important to note that recent modifications to the TraumaMan System have resulted in a change to the air supply system. TraumaMan is now equipped with two separate air supply tubes. For chest tube insertion, cricothyroidotomy, and percutaneous tracheostomy - the ventilator tube should be attached to the air supply tube marked "Airway / Chest Tube" (1). For needle decompression - attach one or both of the air supply tubes to the coupler that is marked "Needle Decompression" (2). Attaching both tubes will increase the rush of air when the needle decompression procedure is performed.

When performing the needle decompression, add 5 to 10 cc's of water into the air bladder. This enhances the auditory aspect of the procedure and provides some misting water when the needle is inserted.

Not getting a rush of air when you insert the needle? Check your needle to make sure it is not cored.
